Highlights from the 2024 GoodCompany Awards:

Origin Energy was crowned the #1 top company for the second consecutive year.

"Origin is incredibly proud to be named the GoodCompany award winner for the second year running, in recognition of our workplace giving, volunteering and charity support," said Michelle Zahra, Head of the Origin Energy Foundation.

Key Trends from 2024:

- **Payroll Giving:** Offered by 77% of companies—up 26% from the previous year—highlighting a growing focus on sustainable employee giving.
- **Open Choice Giving Models:** 64% of companies now allow employees to choose their preferred charity, a significant jump from 50% in 2022.
- **Matched Giving:** 75% of companies match employee donations, with 30% offering uncapped matching.
- **Volunteering Support:** 98% of companies provide paid volunteer leave, and 79% have budgets for team volunteering—up from 69% in 2023.
- **Community Sponsorships:** Many organisations back initiatives in education, health, First Nations programs, climate resilience, and youth wellbeing—supporting charities like Smiling Mind, OzHarvest, YMCA, and local sports clubs.
